1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 For all Harbor 20 boats:
 - a.) The H20 Fleet 1 By-laws (www.harbor20.org) will also apply.
 - b.) RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed such that only one tack and one gybe is required.
- 1.3 US Sailing prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 The Event is open to all sailors who are members of a yacht club and/or members of Harbor 20 Fleet 1. There is no entry fee except for having a good attitude toward the Corinthian spirit of the event.
- 2.2 The Harbor 20 (H20) class will have three (3) divisions, A, B, and C. Five (5) boats are required to come to the starting area for each scheduled race in order to constitute a division eligible for a separate start.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter the series online at nhyc.org by completing the entry form prior to a boat's first race. Sail number changes must be reported to the Race Office prior to racing with the new sail number.
- 2.4 The purpose of these races is to have fun, build great relations among fellow skippers, and to learn and develop skills in sailing.

3. SCHEDULE – Only one registration is required for all races. The scheduled first warning for all dates is 1400.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A. RRS A9 will apply.

7. TROPHIES

- 7.1 Scores will be kept and the winner may be accorded a drink or two or whatever other recognition the organizers may deem appropriate.
- 7.2 An award may also be given to the sailor who best demonstrates the proper Corinthian spirit.
