#### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### **3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

3.1 The *Nuts Regatta* will follow "Appendix U" under US Sailing's racing rules (Audible-Signal Racing System). The Nuts regatta is intending to run up to five (5) collegiate-style races, using a three-minute audible starting sequence. Any changes to the NOR or SI's will be made verbally on the water.

## **5 SCHEDULE OF RACES**

5.1\* Racing will be held on 3/28/2020 starting at 1300.

Racing is open to Harbor 20's (All classes A, B & C)

Up to five (5) races will be sailed

No racing will starting after 1600.

Starting fleets will be determined by the Race Committee on the water, and may vary from race to race.

# 7 RACING AREAS

Racing will be held in the "Five Points" area, also known as the "Turning Basin."

## 8 THE COURSES

Courses will be determined by race committee.

#### 9 MARKS

Marks will be "Hippity Hop" style inflatable buoys.

#### 11 START AND FINISH

The starting and finish line will be between the race committee boat and the starting buoy.

## **14 PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## 17 SCORING

Low Point scoring.

## 28 PRIZES

"Nuts" trophy's will be handed out to the top three boats in each class.
